Why Choose Advanced Studies in Investment?

The Investment Analysis Certificate provides the student in any major with the tools and techniques to evaluate investments.

Admission Requirements

Any person who is admitted to a University degree program or the University Center for Extended Learning is welcome to seek the attainment of this certificate. You must present evidence of graduation from high school with a 2.35 grade point average.

Graduation Requirements

A Ferris student will receive the Certificate in Advanced Studies in Investment upon graduation with a Baccalaureate degree, and after completion of the requirements for the certificate with a minimum 2.0 grade point average in advanced studies in investment course.

No more than 50% of the credits in this certificate may be transferred from another institution, nor will the certificate be granted if more than 50% of the certificate credits are specifically required in the student's major.
