

Elementary Education Language Arts Minor • *Minor*

Teaching Majors and Minors for Elementary Education Majors

The Elementary Education program requires the completion of two elementary education teaching minors or one elementary education teaching major in addition to a planned program to fulfill the subject area requirements of the program. Students may choose from the subject areas of biology, mathematics, social studies, English, language arts, and early childhood. Elementary education teaching majors are only available in the subject areas of biology, mathematics, and social studies. The early childhood minor is an optional minor and is in addition to the subject area major or minors required.

The elementary education teaching language arts minor is recommended for those who wish to teach at the lower-level elementary grades. Students should consult with an advisor to determine if the language arts minor is appropriate for their career goals.

You cannot have an English teaching minor with this language arts teaching minor.

NOTE:

- GPA of 3.0 must be obtained in all required courses,
- a minimum of C in any individual course (or transfer equivalent) within the major, and
- a minimum of B in ENGL 150 and ENGL 250 (general education requirements or their transfer equivalents). A 2.75 GPA is required in the Professional Sequence.
